

ExakTime Synchronization Service is a background service that can be installed on a Server where the TimeSummit Database is hosted that—as long as the Server and Sync Service is running—enables the system to actively and constantly check for and process any new data available. It was designed to alleviate the issue of having to leave a single instance of TimeSummit running to process records.

ExakTime Synchronization Service Installation Steps:

1. After TimeSummit is installed you will need to rerun the TSENTSETUP.exe file and choose the **Modify** option.
2. On the Custom Setup screen select the **Exaktime Synchronization Service** option to be installed on the local hard drive.
3. Complete the installation.
4. Once the installation finishes complete the steps below to start the server.

ExakTime Synchronization Service Start/Restart Steps:

1. On the system where the Sync Service is installed, go to the Start Menu.
2. On Windows Vista or 7 use the Search bar and type **services.msc**, then click Enter.
3. On Windows 8 and higher, right-click in the lower left and select **Run**, then type **services.msc** and click Enter.
4. On the services window that appears, scroll down until you see “Exaktime Synchronization Service.” Right-click it and start the service.
5. If you see that the Service is not set to “Automatic”, right-click it and go into **Properties**, then change it to **Automatic** and apply the change.
